Instructions

Using the items from the scavenger hunt or asking the children to each find one or two special items, spread them out on the ground.

Ask the children to memorise the items – guide them to remember the location, number or items, type of item etc..

If you have blindfolds, hand them out. If not ask them to prepare to close their eyes and put their hands over them.

Count down from five, ask them to cover their eyes (no peeking!)

Remove a number of items, between two and four is the suggested number.

Ask the children to remove their blindfolds and identify what is missing.

This can be repeated as many times as you like, or until the children get bored. You can also ask the children to take it in turns being the one to remove items and take the guesses from the other children.
