

ACTIVITY 17



Pallettes

Season	All

Equipment Needed: Double sided sticky tape, paper cut out into the shape of a palette, a butterfly or whatever shape suites the topic covered.

Safety Notes

Remind children not to pick anything that may be poisonous i.e. berries or harmful i.e. nettles, dog fowl, prickly plants. Ensure the children know the boundaries of the activity and do not wander too far.

Instructions

At your setting / home, cut the paper into the required shape and place a piece of double-sided sticky tape along the centre of it. Allow one per child.

Each child is given one of the palettes, and allowed the given time to collect items to decorate it by removing the sticky tape and fixing small items found in the woodland to it.

This can be done in several ways, i.e. finding as many different colours as possible, finding as many different shades of one colour as possible, repeating the activity in different seasons or at different sites and comparing them.
