

## ACTIVITY 20



### Book Walks

**Equipment Needed:** Books



#### Instructions

There are two book-based activities described here.

#### *We're Going On A Bear Hunt* (Michael Rosen)

Read the book on the site or before the visit. The children colour in cut-out pictures of teddy bears that can be hidden in the trees for the children to find on a walk around the site. They find their own bear and then sit down for a picnic. Actual stuffed teddy bears can be brought and games and activities described above can be carried out during the picnic.

#### *Stickman* (Julia Donaldson)

Read the book on the site. Make a stick man by finding a Y-shaped stick (the Y forms the body and legs) and affixing another stick at right angles to make the arms. Play dough can be used to make the face, or bark scraped off and the face drawn on. Clothes and hair can be made with woodland materials. A mini-den can be made for the stick man and maps and trails can be created to show the way to the den (see activity descriptions above).
