Tree Faces

Season	All

Equipment Needed: One of - Home made play dough* / play dough / plastercine / modelling clay



* To make home-made play dough, mix two-parts flour to one-part salt and one-part water. For twenty children to have a palm-sized lump then mix four cups of flour with two cups of salt and two cups of water. Knead until it has the consistency of dough. Olive oil can be added to make it more pliable. Food colouring can be added to make it different colours.

Instructions

This can be done alongside the 'My Tree' activity.

1. Once a tree has been selected, the play dough is stuck to the trunk of the tree, where a face might be.
2. This is then modelled to look like a face.
3. Items from the woodland such as berries, stones, leaves, plants, mud etc. can be used to make the face.
4. Remove the dough from the tree after completing the activity.
5. Wash hands when finished.
